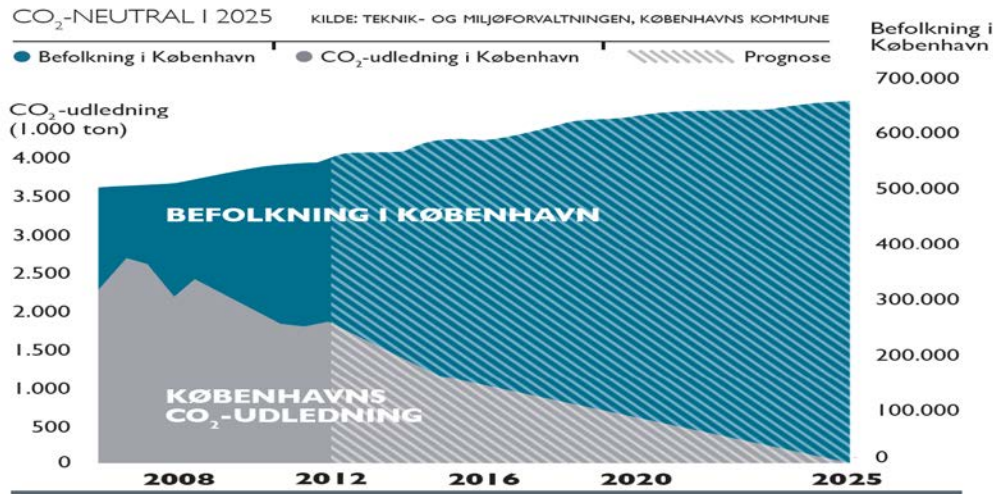

4. EV & other alternative fuels

## PART II: PASSENGER CARS: 100 % Electric/hydrogen by 2025

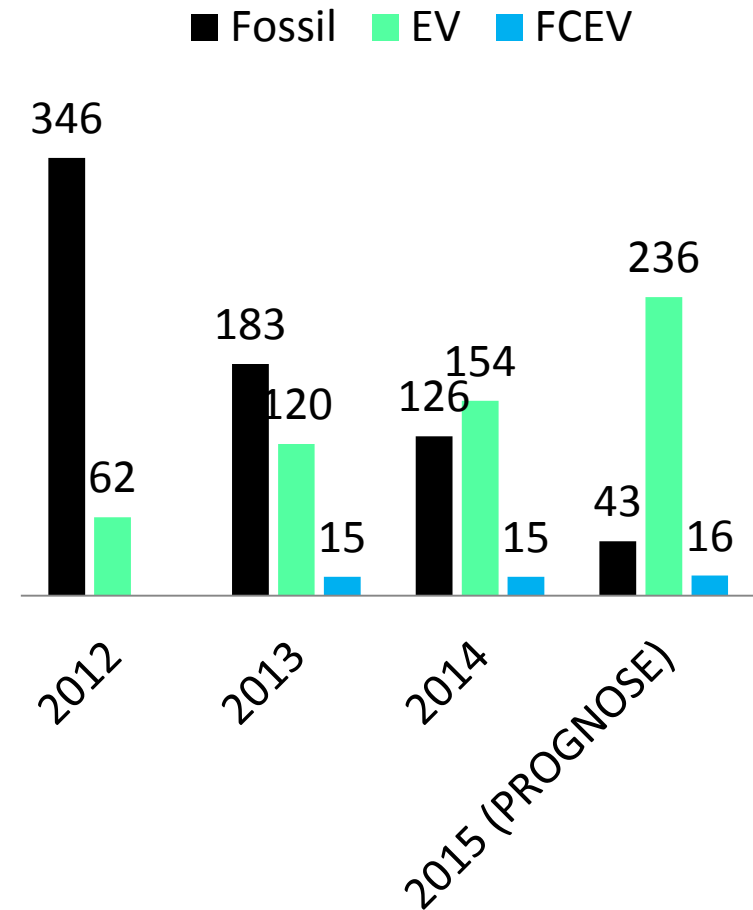
### I. Ambitious goals:

- By 2015 85 % EV or FCEV
- By 2025 100 %

### 2. An early start of the proces

- An organizational turn in 2009. Centralizing management of registration, leasing, procurement & sales (in an office in the Technical & Environmental Department)
- Only buying EVs from 2011

**Status:**  
2012: 15 % EV  
2013: 43 %  
2014: 57 %  
& A cut from 408 to 295,  
before GPS installed





## PART III: LESSONS LEARNED ABOUT EV PASSENGER CARS

### THE CARS:

1. 2009 4-5 pers. car ☹️ Think, Fiat Fiorino, CI
  - Break downs
2. 2011 - Minivans ☹️ Renault Kangoo
  - Range, not only depending on driver
  - Still some reluctance concerning heating and room for tools
3. 2011-2015 5 pers. cars 😊 eg. C-zero, Nissan Leaf
  - + Not technical problems
  - +/- Good range, but depends on driver
  - At times heating difficulties

### THE ORGANIZATION:

- Introducing new technology/building up knowledge
- A choice between two models, not without consequences. The decentralised was chosen:
  - Cars as a tool vs. Cars as a topic
  - Not a centralized knowledgepool (TCO difficult to estimate)
  - Making prognosis & giving general advice
- Not accustomed to working together sharing, eg. cars or parking slots

**= Eg. Initiate courses in ecodriving in EV's & consider if structural changes in procurement & service are necessary**
